Job summary

Reporting to the Clinical Director, the Assistant Clinical Director is required to oversee the student tracking rotation program at Acorn House and to provide operational support to the Clinical Director to ensure that the practice is able to provide a high standard of clinical care on a 24- hour basis.

Specific responsibilities

- Leading the tracking rotation at Acorn House delivering induction and feedback sessions to students, disseminating student feedback to the Acorn team and ensuring continual improvement of the rotation
- Line manager for new graduates
- Organising and leading monthly vet meetings
- Shared responsibility with the Clinical Director for ensuring ongoing service provision at Acorn House, in particular cover on the clinical rota
- Deputising for and assisting the Clinical Director
- Attendance at SLT and (as part of SLT) ensuring maintenance and compliance with accreditation schemes
- Participation in the rota at Acorn House as follows: Mondays 8:30-7 (consults and/or surgery) Tuesdays 8-5:30 (office day) Wednesdays OFF Thursdays 8:30-7 (consults and/or surgery) Fridays 10-8 (with on call alternate weeks)
 6 Saturday day shifts per year (8:30-4:30) and 2 weekends on call per year (Saturday day shift until 4:30 and then on call until Monday morning)
