Water Intake

To increase water intake in your cat try several of the following methods:

• Place water bowls at several points around the house. Cats are notoriously lazy about getting up and seeking water.

• See which flavour water your cat prefers – e.g. rain/tap/cold from fridge/bottled/filtered.

• If your cat likes running water then use an indoor water feature or try a tap dripping fast.

• Allow access to the shower or bath base, some cats will drink from these.

• Use flavoured water from tuna in spring water (not brine), chicken or fish cooked in water. Ice cubes can be made of these and then used to flavour the water bowl.

• Some cats prefer a certain type of water bowl, try glass, metal or ceramic rather than plastic.

• Place the bowl so that your cat can drink without another cat coming up behind them

- Feed as much wet food as you can and reduce dry food intake.
- Add some water to the food
